Amber's Bell Tent Camping Mannington Hall, Norfolk

This is Amber Wykes's third season of hiring out her beautiful bell tents in the grounds of Mannington Hall, a moated medieval country house six miles from Holt and home to the Walpole family since 1560. This year there are seven tents, each sleeping five, plus a shepherd's hut and a vintage caravan, dotted around a 2.5-acre field. Each tent has a comfortable double bed and single camp beds where needed, log burners and storm lanterns plus pretty rugs, bed spreads and blankets. Outside, there is a picnic table, firepit/barbecue, gas stove and vintage-inspired cooking and dining ware. There are also lavatories and showers close by and an honesty shop selling kindling, firewood, cooking gas, coffee, and so on. A field shelter has comfortable seating, table tennis and a wood-burning stove where pizzas are cooked to order at weekends. There is also a wood-fired sauna. The details The bell tents are available until the end of September, the shepherd's hut and vintage caravan for longer. Tents cost from £85 per night, £110 at weekends, with a two-night minimum stay (ambersbelltents.co.uk).
